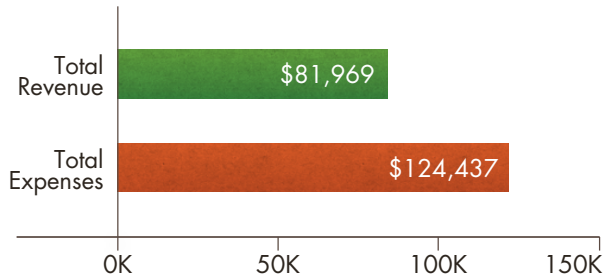

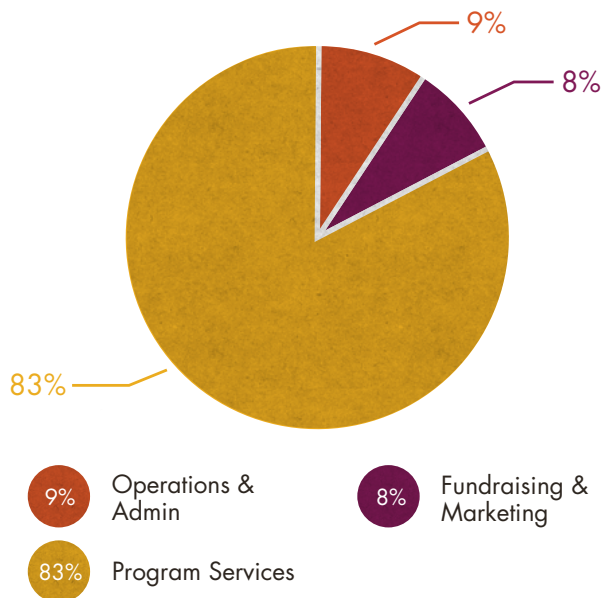
#### Revenue by Category
